 From: 6th & Western, go west to Country Club, south 3 miles to 44th, and west about 0.4 miles to 5407 W. 44th. The drive will be on your left.

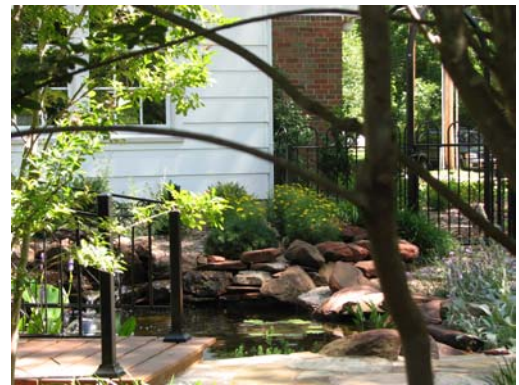
